K-W Singers invite you to celebrate Spring with 'Music in Bloom'

The K-W Singers are holding their annual Spring concert on May 3 & 4 at 7:30pm at Calvin Presbyterian Church, 248 Westmount Rd. E., Kitchener.

Directed by Jane Gingerich and accompanied by Donna Mak, the choir will be performing an assortment of numbers, including Billy Joel's *And So It Goes*, a gospel-inspired rendition of *Will The Circle Be Unbroken*, and *Night Yoik* which is inspired by the Sámi people of northern Europe. The concert will conclude with *Rodgers and Hammerstein On Broadway* – a medley featuring favourites from *The Sound of Music*, *Oklahoma*, *South Pacific*, and more.

The concert will also include guest performances from piano students Justin Bian, Elmer Lei, Elvin Lei, Jennifer Jia & Phoebe Lin.

Refreshments are available at a reception after the concert, along with a chance to mingle with the choir and performers.

Tickets are \$10 and will be available at the door, from any choir member or requested through the website (kwsingers.org).

ABOUT THE CHOIR

Originally founded in 1948 as the Dominion Life Choir, the K-W Singers is a multi-age, four-part adult choir located in Kitchener, Ontario. The choir performs two concerts per year, in December and April/May. They also perform mini concerts in retirement homes throughout the community.

The choir is a registered charity and supports itself through donations, ticket sales and various fundraising activities. Jane Gingerich has been the director since 2010, and Donna Mak has been the accompanist since 1998.
